CONTEST RULES

- 1. Registration is from 11 to 12:30 Saturday and Sunday. Contestant must draw for placement at time of registration or a number will be assigned to them. Contestant will receive one guest pass.
- 2. Judging will be done on "Old Time Fiddling and Danceability". No hokum bowing, plucking or cross tuned fiddles allowed, except in the Trick and Fancy division.
- 3. All fiddlers will play 3 tunes a hoedown, waitz and a tune of choice, other than a hoedown or waitz. No tune may be played more than once by the same contestant (Other than when playing for an Accompanist contestant).
- 4. Contestants may play without an accompanist, or with no more than two (2) accompanists.
- 5. A five minute time limit is enforced. Five points will be deducted for each 10 seconds over time. No tuning on stage. Time starts with the first draw of the bow.
- 6. No contact microphones, electrical or amplified instruments or music stands allowed at any time during the contest.
- 7. Accompanist division contestants must have accompanied at least one fiddler during the contest. Two tunes will be played, one fast and one slow.
- 8. Twin fiddlers will play two tunes. A waltz and a tune of choice other than a waltz. Trick and Fancy/Hot Fiddle will play one tune of their choice, anything goes.
- 9. The top three winners in each age division will be eligible to enter the Grand Champion division. The 4th, 5th & 6th place winners are eligible for the Runner Up Champion Division. Three tunes will be played, following Rule #3. Contestants must draw numbers, or one will be drawn for you.
- 10. If a contestant or accompanist breaks a string or a peg slips, they have the option of starting the tune over or have the tune judged as played. A maximum of five (5) minutes will be allowed to fix the problem.
- 11. All fiddlers and accompanists will meet with the judges and coordinator at 12:30 PM, Saturday. Any questions you have will be answered at this time.
- 12. Any infringement of the above rules will result in the offender losing points and/or disqualification.
- 13. Please wear appropriate clothing, i.e., long pants, no tank tops, shorts, etc.
- 14. All decisions of the judges and contest coordinator will be final.
