

Greetings fellow fiddlers,

I would like to give the members of the AOTFA an update. The status of the 2025 Tucson Fiddle Contest is a little uncertain. I will be having surgery in September and consequently my normal fundraising efforts will be restricted this fall. In addition, I have been unable to gain any financial commitment from the local business community. Many of the sponsors we have had in the past are not responding so I must assume they are no longer interested. Some funding we have received in the past from cultural organizations is also questionable this year due to changes in priority.


I have enough funds left over from this year's contest to cover prize money. They went on to have three children, Raymond, David, and Tiona. On June 15, 1947 Emmett married Helen Kneppelt in Dover, Ohio.




