If you are not aware or familiar, this contest and event is hosted by the Town of Payson and now run by the Parks & Tourism Director, Courtney Spawn.

We would like to express gratitude to Nelson Beck who oversaw the contest for many years and through his efforts and those of several others was able to keep the town financially supporting the contest so that it remains today. My hope is that the contest might grow and become self-supporting to the point that in a few years it would cost the town absolutely nothing beyond possibly providing a location.

The last two years the interest especially by the young players has grown to the point that it is difficult to get everyone in & out of the facilities and get all of the players a fair chance to be heard. It would be great if the level of interest is as good as previous years if musicians could split into smaller groups and go play at various businesses around town to raise awareness in the community.

The Arizona Bluegrass Association has also graciously offered room in their monthly The Beacon newsletter to let their members know that the State Fiddle Championship is also a great place to come camp and jam with acoustic musicians even if you're not a fiddler. Over the years there have been many of us who belonged to both organizations, recognizing the distinctions between the two genres but also enjoying playing both. Far more enjoyable though is associating with the wonderful family of fine people who have always been attracted to and play old time fiddle, bluegrass, old-timey, country and other related styles on primarily acoustic instruments. If you camp or have an RV (some today are hardly camping :-) there is ample room at the Event Center in Payson where the contest portion of the event is held. It is dry camping with no amenities for \$10 a night.
